Abstract Submission

Interested participants are invited to submit their abstracts for oral or poster presentations to the Conference Secretariat by electronically sending a **500 words abstract**, written in English, with a title, the name of the author(s) and affiliation(s) in MS Word format. The abstract should clearly communicate the aim and content of the presentation. All abstracts **will be reviewed** for presentation by the Conference Scientific Committee. Presented papers will be included in the **Conference Proceedings** and in **IEEE Explore**. For each presented paper or poster, one presenter will have to fully register to the Conference. Guidelines for preparation of papers and posters will be provided in due time.
